II. NEMSIS 3.5

- Visibility and Validation rules completed
 - Estimated date of migrate, October 2023
 - Demoed the new NEMSIS 3.5 ePCR and went over key changes
 - An email will be sent out to providers once the preview is ready in the library, hopefully by July 1st
- Currently QA workflows to streamline the workflows
 - Nick asked for volunteers to provide a list of names for crews who would like to test out the pcr before implementation
 - Cal Fire and AMR will give Nick a list of names to authorize for testing first
 - Testing will most likely take place late July/early August before rollout in the Fall

III. Identified Issues and System Updates

- Narcotic Signature transfer is fixed
 - Transfer settings, added controlled substances, but will not transfer narcotic signatures
- System lag and instability the past couple of weeks
 - Lag and instability were due to the data mart server farm losing connection at some point
 - It was resolved within the hour
 - No one seems to have any errors since then
 - Providers noticed the system lagging more, as well as in ReportWriter
- PDF fixes related to IP restricted access
 - Fixed and upgrade will be out in a couple of weeks so that Cal Fire can resume printing PDFs
